

Project Title: "Industry Baby': A Workshop on Post-Graduation Career Hopes and Expectations in Wimbledon's Acting and Performance Programme"

This participatory workshop will explore students' attitudes, perceptions, hopes, and expectations related to a career in the field of acting. Through a number of different creative exercises and discussions, the workshop will be in three parts. First students will collectively map out the terrain of what they perceive to be "the industry" in small collaborative groups. In the second part, students will creatively reflect on their personal goals and aspirations. Finally, we will collectively brainstorm the kinds of skills, knowledge, and experiences students believe they will need to acquire in order to achieve those goals.

The aim of this workshop is twofold. As a research activity, the information gathered will be shared with the teaching staff at UAL in order to allow us to better support our students in their professionalization journey. At the same time, the workshop is itself a professionalization event that will empower and inspire students in their professional growth.
